Product Form	Purified IgG conjugated to Biotin - lyophilised
Reconstitution	Reconstitute with 0.5ml sterile PBS containing 0.1% Bovine Serum Albumin. Care should be taken during reconstitution as the protein may appear as a film at the bottom of the vial. Bio-Rad recommend that the vial is gently mixed after reconstitution. N.B. For long term storage the addition of 0.09% sodium azide is recommended.
Antiserum Preparation	Antisera to mouse IL-13 were raised by repeated immunisations of rabbits with highly purified antigen. Purified IgG was prepared from whole serum by affinity chromatography.

Rabbit anti Mouse Interleukin-13 antibody recognizes mouse Interleukin-13 (IL-13), a 12.3kDa immunoregulatory cytokine produced primarily by activated T helper type 2 (Th2) cells and also by mast cells and NK cells.

The biological properties of IL-13 include stimulation of B cell proliferation and antibody production and studies suggest that IL-13 plays an important role in the induction of the pathophysiological features of allergic asthma, independently of Immunoglobulin E and eosinophils ([Wills-Karp et al. 1998](#)).

ELISA

AAM34B may be used in a direct ELISA or as the detection reagent in a sandwich ELISA with [AAM34](#) as the capture antibody.

Storage

Prior to reconstitution store at +4°C. Following reconstitution store at -20°C.

This product should be stored undiluted.

Storage in frost-free freezers is not recommended. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing as this may denature the antibody. Should this product contain a precipitate we recommend microcentrifugation before use.

Shelf Life

12 months from date of reconstitution.
