Specificity

Goat anti Pig IP-10 antibody recognizes porcine interferon gamma-inducible protein 10 (IP-10), also known as CXCL10. IP-10 is expressed in a variety of tissues including liver, gut, spleen, kidney and thymus, in response to interferon gamma stimulation.

IP-10 acts as a chemoattractant for monocytes, NK cells and certain T-cells.

ELISA

This product may be used as a detection antibody in a sandwich ELISA together with [AHP2388](#) as the capture reagent. Recombinant Pig IP-10 ([PPP020](#)) may be used as a standard.
