Specificity	Rabbit anti Human IKK alpha antibody recognize IKK, a serine protein kinase. The IKK complex consists of the alpha subunit IKK alpha and the beta subunit IKK beta. Both IKK alpha and IKK beta subunits are required for NFkB activation.
	Rabbit anti Human IKK alpha antibody (AHP544) recognizes human IKK alpha and does not cross react with IKK Beta or IKK gamma.
