Specificity

Mouse anti Human PSMD1 antibody recognizes PSMD1 , also known as 26S proteasome regulatory subunit RPN2, 26S proteasome regulatory subunit S1, 26S proteasome subunit p112.

The 26S proteasome is a multicatalytic proteinase complex with a highly ordered structure

composed of 2 complexes, a 20S core and a 19S regulator. The 20S core is composed of 4 rings of 28 non-identical subunits; 2 rings are composed of 7 alpha subunits and 2 rings are composed of 7 beta subunits. The 19S regulator is composed of a base, which contains 6 ATPase subunits and 2 non-ATPase subunits, and a lid, which contains up to 10 non-ATPase subunits. Proteasomes are distributed throughout eukaryotic cells at a high concentration and cleave peptides in an ATP/ubiquitin-dependent process in a non-lysosomal pathway. An essential function of a modified proteasome, the immunoproteasome, is the processing of class I MHC peptides. PSMD1 encodes the largest non-ATPase subunit of the 19S regulator lid, which is responsible for substrate recognition and binding. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been found for PSMD1 (provided by RefSeq, Jul 2010).

Mouse anti Human PSMD1 antibody detects a band of 106 kDa. The antibody has been extensively validated for western blotting using whole cell lysates.
